Aishwarya Tomar of class VI-E participated in Dance competition organized by Association of Gwalior Youth Society . She has been awarded with a medal and certificate.



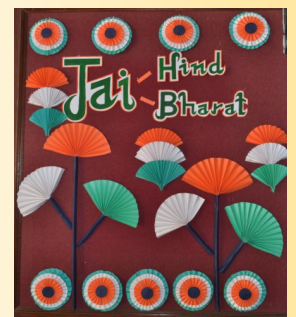
Competitions Beyond Precincts
