

## Report on Teachers' Orientation Programme 2026–27

The programme was conducted by the distinguished educationist and CBSE Master Trainer, **Mr. Anurag Gupta**, Principal, Vidya Niket School, Gwalior.

### **Session I : Changes in CBSE Secondary School Curriculum**

A thought-provoking discussion was held on the distinction between Learning Objectives and Learning Outcomes, helping teachers understand how outcomes-driven education can lead to meaningful and measurable student achievement.



The session encouraged educators to align their teaching practices with the evolving expectations of the CBSE curriculum and to focus on holistic student development rather than rote learning.

## Session II : Focusing on Attainment of Learning Outcomes through Bloom's Taxonomy

The second session centered on strategies for achieving learning outcomes by effectively utilizing Bloom's Taxonomy. Mr. Gupta emphasized the need for a holistic approach that addresses the three domains of learning :

- Cognitive Domain (Head)
- Affective Domain (Heart)
- Psychomotor Domain (Hand)

He highlighted the teacher's role in stimulating a child's curiosity, intent, and intrinsic motivation to learn. The session underscored the importance of nurturing critical and analytical thinking, creativity, innovation, and other 21st-century skills that prepare learners for future challenges.



An engaging discussion on the R1, R2, and R3 Framework provided practical insights into reflective and effective teaching practices. Mr. Gupta also elaborated on the concepts of Kaushal Bodh and Kaushal Vikas, emphasizing the development of vocational awareness and skills among students.

Particular attention was given to the assessment and evaluation of Kaushal Bodh, Kaushal Vikas, Art Education, and Physical Education, in accordance with contemporary educational reforms and competency-based assessment practices.
